

Official Seal of Tacloban City

The Official Seal of Tacloban City is the symbol of her identity where its meaning was inscribed when it became a City under Republic Act 760 on June 20, 1952.

The City's emblem stands for the following physical attributes and character:

Right Portion - Leyte side, where Tacloban City is located

Left Portion - Symbolizes the Province of Samar, major supplier of agricultural and marine products to the city, augmenting the local agricultural products of the city and stabilizing its volume of business and trade

Center - Stands for the beautiful and scenic San Juanico Strait

Galleon - Illustrates the ship of Ferdinand Magellan who discovered the island of Limasawa where the first Christian mass was held in Philippine soils.
